**trans: across**

- circumvent (verb): to go around or bypass; to avoid by artful deception
- circumspect (adj.): wary and unwilling to take risks
- circumnavigate (verb): to sail all the way around (something, especially the world)
- circulate (verb): to move in a circle; to pass or cause to pass from person to person or from place to place
- circuit (noun): a roughly circular line, route, or movement that starts and finishes at the same place
- circumference (noun): the distance around something; Circle=  $2 \times 3.14 (r)$
- transcontinental (noun/adj): crossing a continent
- transcribe (verb): put thoughts into written or printed form; simplifying or translating a foreign text
- transform (verb): make a thorough or dramatic change in the form, appearance, or character of
- translate (verb): restate (words) from one language into another language
- translucent (adj.): not completely clear or transparent, but clear enough to allow light to pass through
- transparent (adj.): easily understood or seen through

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
