

fac/fic: make/do

- benefactor (noun): a person who gives aid (especially money)
- deface (verb): to disfigure; to ruin the surface
- facilitate (verb): to make easier
- pacification (noun): an attempt to create or maintain peace.
- maleficent (adj.): harmful or evil in intent or effect
- pontificate (verb): talk in a dogmatic and pompous manner
- soporific (adj.): sleep inducing
- edifice (noun): a structure that has walls and a roof

Note: To merit being called an edifice, a building must be important. A mini temple can be an edifice, or a towering sky scraper.

- prolific (adj.): intellectually productive
- ramification (noun): a development that complicates a situation; the act of branching out or dividing into sections
- beatific (adj.): characterized by complete joy; resembling or befitting an angel or saint
- ratification (noun): making something valid by formally confirming it
