- prologue (noun): a separate introductory section of a literary or musical work
- monologue (noun): a long dramatic speech by a single person
- epilogue (noun): a short passage added at the end of a literary work
- analogous (adj.): similar or equivalent in some respects though are otherwise dissimilar (ie: brains and computers)
- pathology (noun): a branch of medicine that studies diseases
- acronym (noun): a word formed from the initial letters of the several words in a name
- eponym (noun): the person for whom something was named
- heteronym (noun): two words are heteronyms if they are spelled the same way but differ in pronunciation
- homonym (noun): two words are homonyms if they are pronounced or spelled the same way but have different meanings
- onomatopoeia (noun): using words that imitate the sound they make
- oronym (noun): a strong of words or a phrase that sounds the same as another string of words or a phrase.
- pseudonym (noun): a fictitious name, especially one used by an author
