## Phil: love

- philosopher: a 'lover of wisdom'
- philanthropist: a 'lover of humans,' that is, someone who is charitable to and does good deeds for the good of humankind as a whole.
- philologist: a 'lover of words'
- hemophiliac: a 'lover of blood'. This does not mean that hemophiliacs are vampires, but rather that they 'love blood' because their platelets are ineffective at clotting wounds; they therefore lose a lot of blood when wounded, causing them to need more, hence 'loving' and needing extra.
- bibliophile: 'loves books'
- hydrophilic: 'love water'
- philharmonic: loving harmony; devoted to music; a symphony orchestra
- philomuse: affection and devotion to literature and the arts
- philology: study (love) of language and literature
- philodendron: a type of plant that curls up or twines around trees as it climbs; 'loves trees'
- philter: love potion
- Phillip: loves horses
