

pot/pol: power

cit/poli: citizen, city, state

- potent (adj): having great influence; having a strong physiological or chemical effect
- impotent (adj.): lacking power or authority
- nepotism (noun): favoritism shown to friends or relatives by those in power
- despot (noun): a cruel and oppressive dictator
- omnipotent (adj): having unlimited power
- metropolis (noun): a large and densely populated urban area
- citadel (noun): a stronghold into which people could go for shelter during a battle
- necropolis (noun): a large and elaborate cemetery belonging to an ancient city
- citation (noun): an official award (as for bravery or service) usually given formally; a violation of a minor law within a city or state; a short note recognizing a source of information or of a quoted passage
- megalopolis (noun): a unified urban region comprising several large cities and their surrounding areas; a very large urban complex usually comprising several cities and towns
- cosmopolitan (adj.): sophisticated in an international way; familiar with and at ease around many different cultures
- impolitic (adjective) : unwise; not exhibiting good judgment
