- **recall** (verb): to call back, ask for something to be returned; bring back into one's mind; remember
- **restrict** (verb): limit one's actions
- **reside** (verb): to live in a particular place
- **reassure** (verb): to give or to restore confidence in; cause to feel sure or certain
- **rebound** (verb): to bounce back
- **reclaim** (verb): to take back; retrieve
- **restore** (verb): repair or renovate
- **reimburse** (verb): to give money back, to pay back
- **reelect** (verb): to vote someone into office again
- **revive** (verb): to bring or come back to life, consciousness, activity or use; to make fresh or strong again
- **reflect** (verb): throw back (heat, sound, or light) without absorbing it ; to think seriously and carefully
- **rehabilitate** (verb): to restore to a former state, reputation, condition, health, or state of efficiency

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
