

- **tact/tang/tig/tag/ting: touch; reach; affect**

- **foli: leaf**

- tact (noun): consideration when dealing with others
- contingent (adj.): possible but not certain; dependent on circumstances that follow
- tangible (adj.): capable of being touched
- contiguous (adj.): sharing a common border; touching
- contagion (noun): a disease spread by the close contact of one person to another
- tangent (noun): a completely different line of thought or action; a straight line that touches a curved surface at a point, but does not cross it
- tactile (adj.): producing a sensation of touch
- intact (adj.): lacking nothing essential; not damaged
- foliage (noun): all of the leaves on a plant
- folic acid (noun): vitamin contained in leafy green vegetables
- folio (noun): pages (leaves) of a manuscript
- defoliant (noun): a chemical that removes the leaves from trees and plants and is often used in warfare
